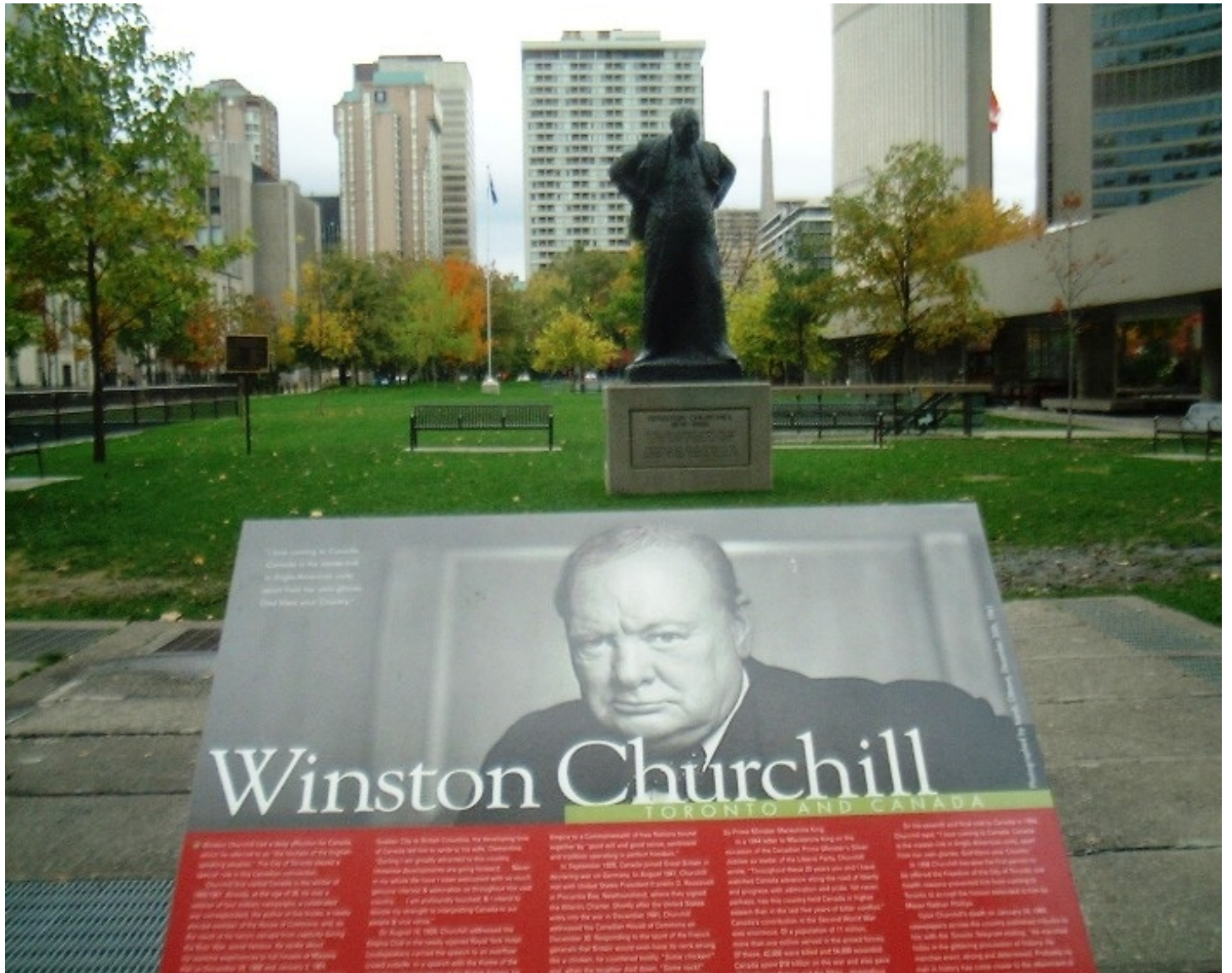

# Winston Churchill

TORONTO AND CANADA

Winston Churchill had a deep affection for Canada, which he expressed in the words of the popular saying: "The City of Toronto is not a city, it is the City of Canada."

Churchill first visited Canada in the winter of 1900-1901. At the age of 81, he paid a visit to the country, accompanied by his wife, Clementine, and his son, Randolph. He was a member of the House of Commons and at the time of his visit, he was the leader of the Conservative Party.

On August 18, 1900, Churchill addressed the House of Commons on the subject of the Canadian question. He said: "I am profoundly touched by the interest which the House of Commons has taken in the Canadian question. It is a mark of the progress of the Empire."
